In June 1962, the US Army's 1st Aviation Company (Caribou) self-deployed 18 AC-1A (later CV-2B or C-7B) de Havilland of Canada Caribou aircraft, from Ft Benning, GA to Korat RTAFB, via Greenland, Iceland, Europe and the Middle East. \*See "The Aerie" for complete flight details\*.

Our mission was to support Joint Task Force (JTF) 116, and other SEATO units, sent to Thailand to prevent a possible Communist incursion. Also at Korat was a Royal New Zealand Air Force Squadron, flying Bristol "Freighters", a large twin-engine transport with fixed gear. A RTAF training school, flying T-6's was also there. The US Army UTT Armed Helicopter Company, with HU-1B aircraft, was TDY from Okinawa to Korat, but left for Saigon in Sep '62.

The 1st Aviation Company kept 10 Caribou at Korat and sent 8 to Vietnam, until 31 December 62, when the entire Company deployed to Vung Tau, RVN.

I returned to Bangkok, with my family, from '64-'66, flying for JUSMAG. Flew Bob Hope up-country at Christmas time '64 & '65. Back to RVN '67-'68 flying CH-47 Chinooks. Retired in June '75 after 26 years.
