One of my old Thud maintenance crew chiefs buddy's named JJ Smith was responsible for having the plaques on the old monument moved to a new place. The Thai Parliament in Bangkok gave JJ a gold watch for his work in orchestrating the monument being moved to a new location.

Over the years they (Thai government) built an over pass on top of the original monument. As you look at one of the photos of the plaques, the top plaque which has a man and bird type image is very sacred to the Thai people. As you Thailand vets recall it is a disgrace to raise your foot to a Thai national.
